UK Automotive Strategy



“Tier 1, 2, 3, n UK suppliers are not seen as competitive compared to offshore alternatives. This leads to OEM’s & tier-ones driving increased levels of manufacturing offshore which eventually leads to increased supply chain risk and complexity and a long term erosion of UK manufacturing capability.”

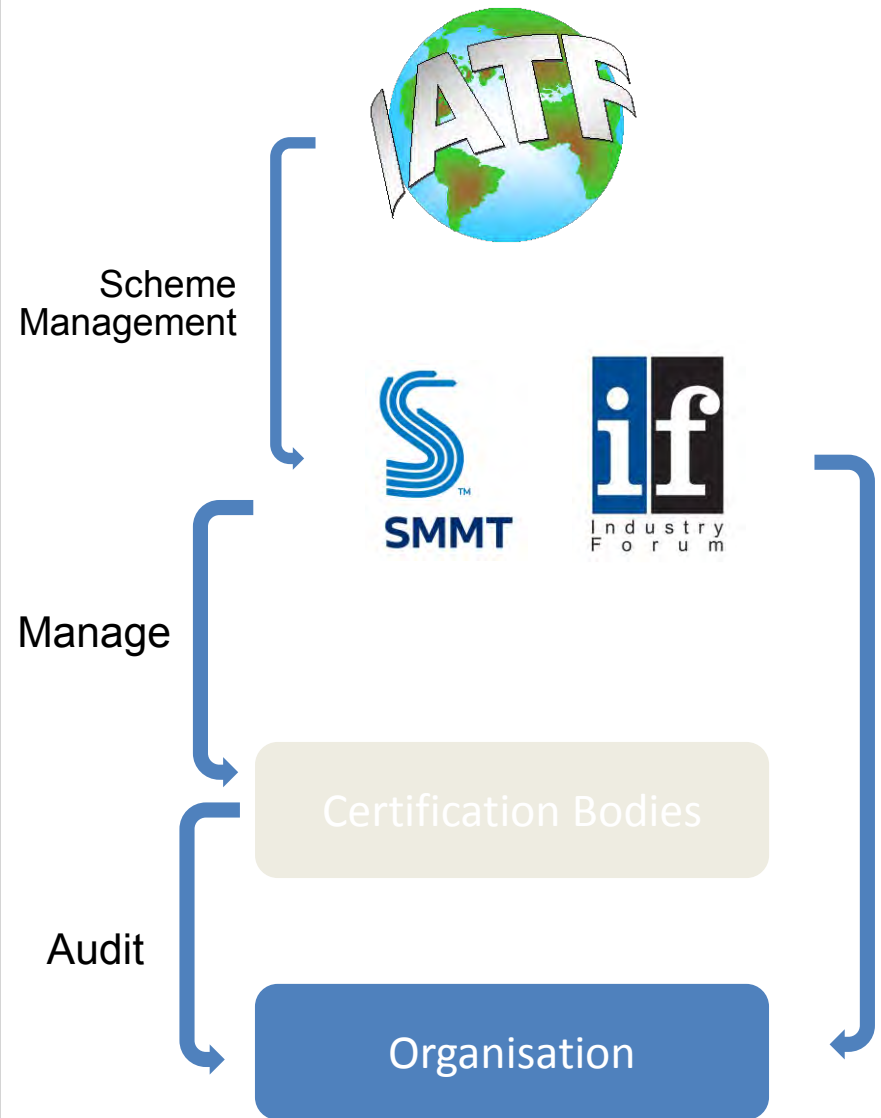

Roles of SMMT and Industry Forum



Key Changes

- More focus on pre-audit planning
- More focus on auditing all processes on all shifts
- Mandatory suspension for major non-conformities
- Responsibility to provide corrective action to address non-conformities in 60 days from closing meeting

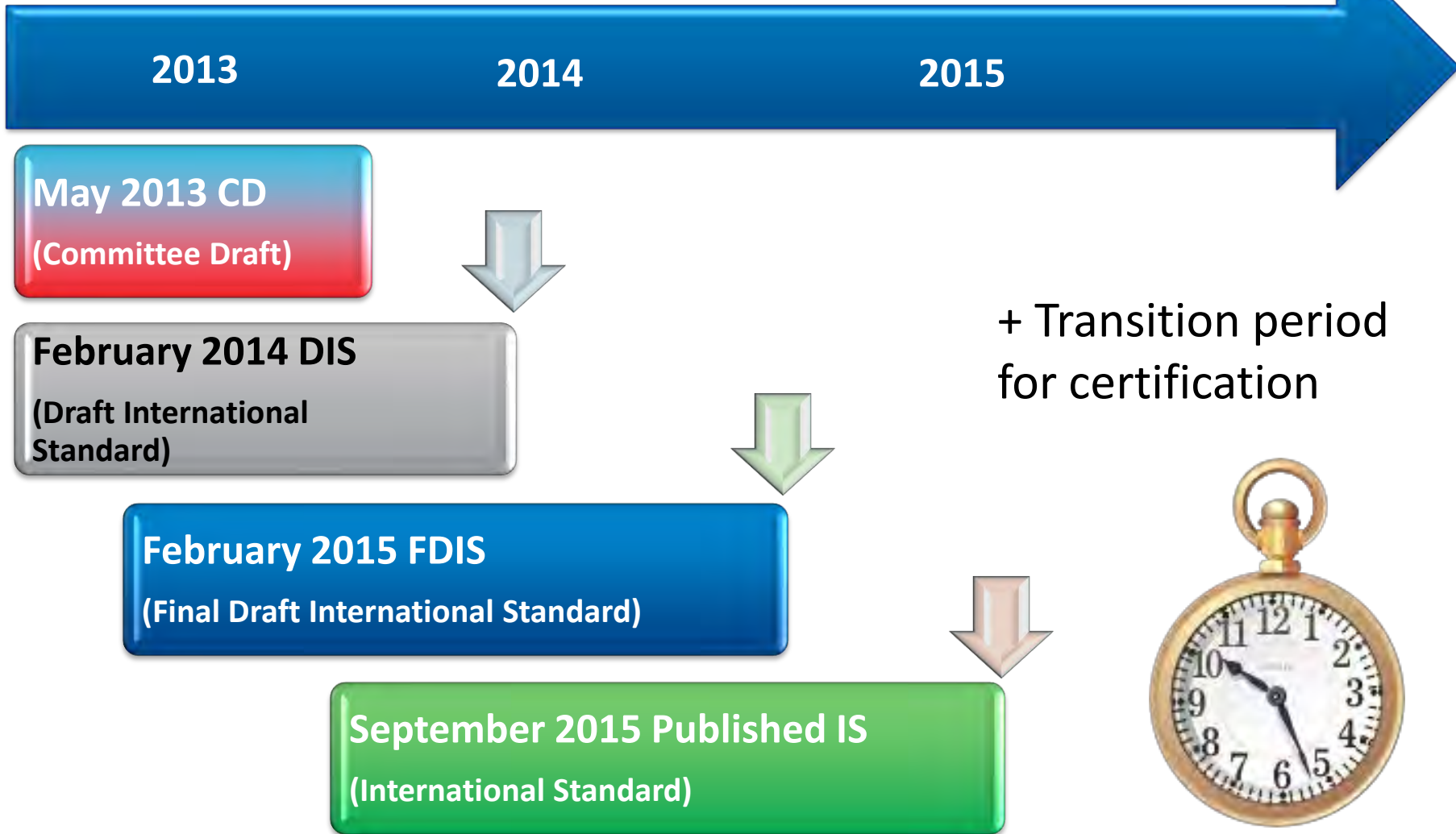


Reasons For The Changes

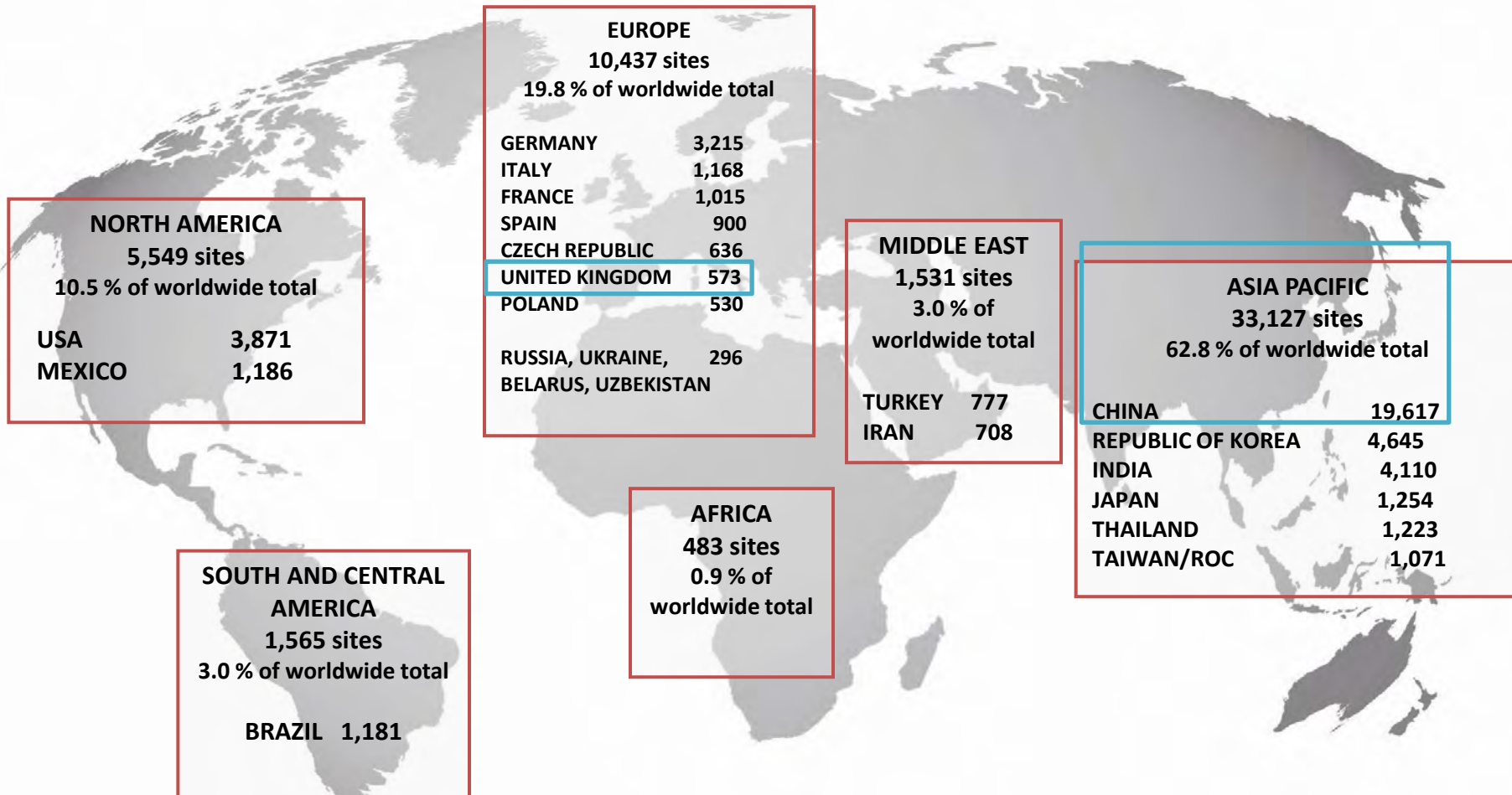
- ISO process for review every 5 years to ensure ongoing relevance, taking into account user feedback
- Decrease the emphasis on **Documentation**
- Increase the emphasis on **Achieving Value** for the Organization and its customers
- Increase emphasis on **Risk Management** to achieve objectives

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Impact on ISO/TS16949

IATF decision in March 2014

Options:

- Align ISO/TS16949 with revised ISO9001
- Break away from ISO9001 and create a standalone standard
- Webinar poll of over 150 people: 91% said that IATF should keep alignment with ISO9001
